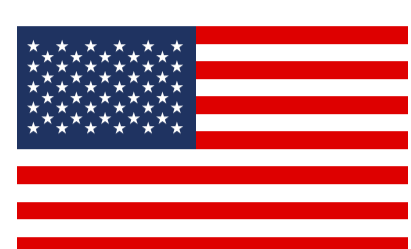

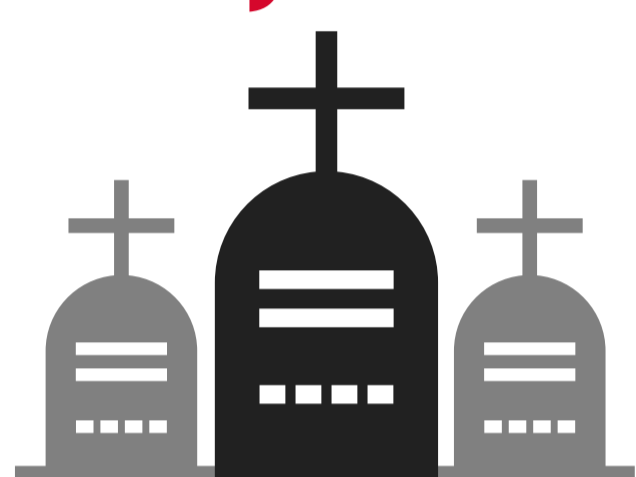

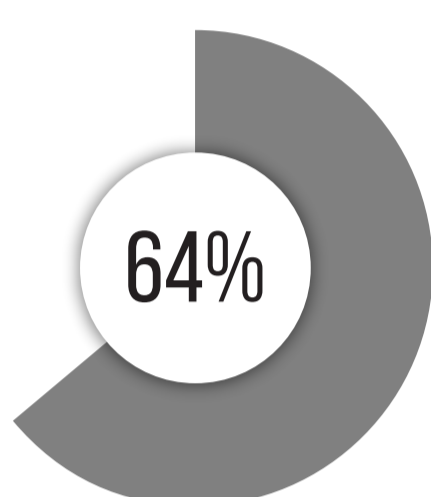
NUMBER OF PASSENGER VEHICLES REGISTERED IN THE UNITED STATES



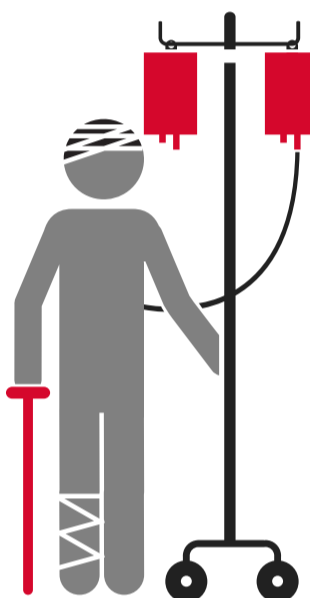

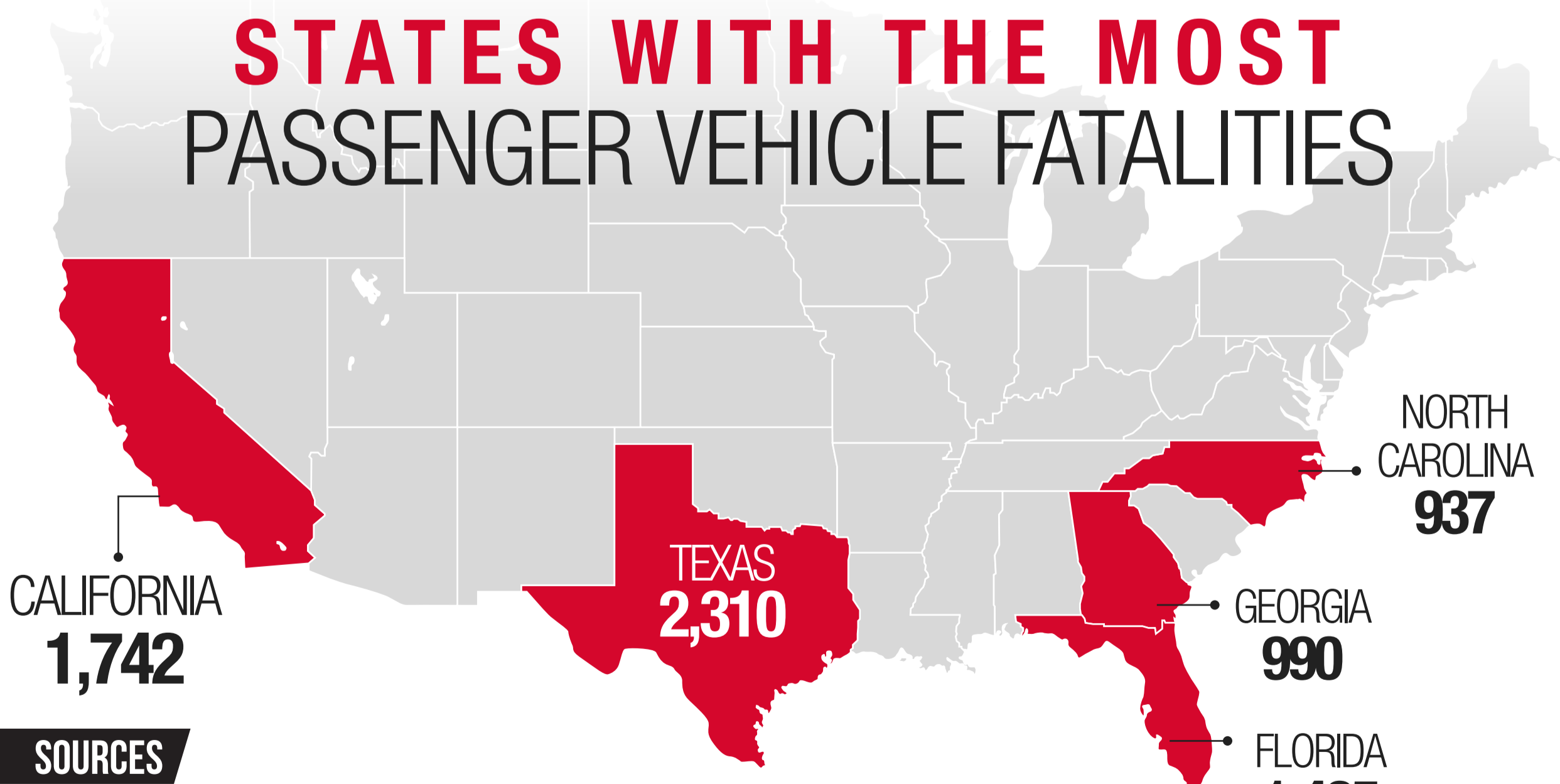
